Bridgeport Hospital continues Picture That's expansion into the healthcare facilities art consulting sector which has emerged as the "busiest and fastest growing segment of our business," said Ms. Cooper. She added: "We have positioned our firm to meet the needs of hospitals and other healthcare providers that are constructing new facilities and undertaking major renovations in a rapidly changing healthcare services landscape focused on outpatient services."
